Course Title: RADAR/LIDAR Instructor School

Date: February 24 - 28, 2014 (0800 -1700)

Course Description:

This is the instructor course required for state certification as a RADAR and LIDAR instructor. Students must successfully estimate the speed of 50 vehicles (25 stationary/25 moving) +/- 3 mph average during the course. Students are also required to pass a comprehensive written examination with a score of 70% or greater. All students will prepare two 5 – 10 minute presentations assigned by the instructors. Prior LIDAR training is not necessary for this course. If your department has any LIDAR equipment, bring a unit on the first day.

Prerequisites:

Students enrolled in this course should have a general instructor certification and should have been a certified RADAR operator for at least two years with RADAR enforcement currently part of their routine duties. Students must also be current on their RADAR operator certification.

Other Requirements:

All Cardinal Criminal Justice Academy member agency personnel must complete a 24 hour apprenticeship in an entry level class prior to receiving their RADAR instructor certification.

Fee: No fee for member agencies
(Non-member agency personnel will be admitted on a seats available basis.)
\$500 per officer for non-member agency personnel

In-service Credit: 40 hours (4 legal/36 career development)

Class Size: Maximum 15 students
